Dear Parent/Carer

As you may have noticed over half term we have made a number of changes to the front of the college building including barriers being installed to prevent parking on the grass.

We have been increasingly aware that our students were at risk due to the number of cars parked at the front of the building and how this made it difficult for them to safely leave the site. This did at times make it difficult for our buses to manoeuvre.

We are also concerned that despite the yellow chevrons on the front road, a number of parents continue to use this as a parking area.

If you need to arrive early, we would appreciate it if you parked your car at the car park near the all-weather pitch at The Peele Leisure Centre. Students will be able to exit the college via the adjacent gate.

Furthermore, we have a number of students who cycle to college and do so sensibly and safely. However, a few continue to flout the rules and cycle out of the site as opposed to wheeling their bikes to the main road. Students who continue to do this will be asked not to bring their bikes to the college.

As a college we are aware that dropping off and collecting students from college is a very emotive issue, but I hope that you will support us in these changes to ensure the safety of all of our students.
