Dear Parents/Carers

RE: School Uniform

In preparation for the students return after the Christmas holidays, I write to remind all students, parents and carers of the high standards we expect from our students in regard to school uniform. We believe that a smart uniform, properly worn, is fundamental in supporting what we as a college wish to achieve.

It has come to my attention that some students are wearing skinny jeans and leggings as part of their uniform which does not comply with the college rules. It has also been noted that pupils are wearing black plimsolls instead of proper black shoes. This not only is against college rules but is also a health and safety concern especially in winter weather conditions.

All information regarding school uniform can be found on the school website, but as a reminder please see the information below:

White shirt – with buttoned collar, top button done up.

College tie (available from Rob Horspool, Design and Embroidery)

Black Jumper, with college logo (available from Rob Horspool, Design and Embroidery)

Black trousers or skirt; skirt should be no more than 2 inches above knee length. No tube skirts.

Black college shoes – Training shoes, boots or **plimsolls** are not permitted footwear.

Black or white socks or black tights.

Belts – plain black only.

Jewellery - Students are allowed to wear wristwatches, one pair of stud earrings, a necklace inside their shirt and a flat ring. No other jewellery or body piercings will be permitted. The rationale behind these decisions concerns safety and security.

Clothing made from **denim** and corduroy, including jeans, is not permitted in college.

Hair Colour should be natural, no bright colours, no different colours and no bandanas.

Nail varnish and false nails are not permitted to be worn in college.

I hope that you will continue to support the college in our drive to ensure that all students take a pride in their appearance and continue to uphold the expectations we have of all.
