

YEAR 11 GENERAL INFORMATION

Study Leave and Revision Classes

- All students must attend every lesson in full college uniform until the final assembly as decided by the Headteacher.
- After the final assembly students need to attend all subject lessons, until they have completed **all** examinations in that subject. Uniform must be worn at all times in college.
- Revision will take place in lesson time until examinations have been completed.
- Extra-curricular revision will also continue within departments.

Text Books

- All text books and college resources must be handed in to your subject teachers by the start of the final subject examination.

Results

- GCSE results will be available at the college on Thursday 24th August 2017.
- You can collect your results from 10.00am – 11.00am.
- Support is available to discuss results and Post 16 options and courses.
- If you are allowing a family member or friend to collect results for you, we must have written permission from you. The person collecting your results must have photographic ID with them on the day.

Certificates

- Your certificates will arrive in college late in the Autumn term.
- You will be invited to the ACE ceremony (date to be confirmed) to celebrate your examination successes and receive your certificates.
- If you are unable to attend, you can collect your certificates from the college reception after the presentation ceremony has taken place. Please contact Mrs Hawes, the Exams Officer to arrange collection.
- All certificates must be signed for.

Coursework

- Coursework is usually returned to college by the examination boards by the end of December.
- If you wish to collect your coursework, please telephone the college to arrange a mutually convenient time.
- Coursework cannot be stored indefinitely, it must be collected by 31st January 2018 or it may be disposed of.
